### A. God teaches through visual aids:

1. Romans 15:4; 1 Corinthians 10:6, 11; 2 Timothy 3:16, 17
2. Sacrifices:
  - a. 5 Sacrifices: Burnt, Cereal, Peace, Trespass and Sin
  - b. “gorban” = to draw near or approach
  - c. Hebrews 10:1, 4, 10-12

### B. Leviticus 1 “Burnt Sacrifice”

1. Most basic of the sacrifices. \_\_\_\_\_ burning and was done every \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. (Lev 6:12, 13)

### C. Leviticus 2 “Cereal Sacrifice”

2. Different forms could be offered. (Lev 2:1, 4, 5, 7, 14)
3. The essence of this sacrifice was \_\_\_\_\_. Humanity as God intended it to be lived. John 6
4. It was to be fine \_\_\_\_\_. (Lev 2:1, 2, 4, 5, 7)
5. Three things always had to be included:
  - a. Oil = mingled and poured over. (Lev 2:1, 2, 4-7, 15)
  - b. Frankincense (Lev 2:1, 2, 9, 12, 15)
  - c. Salt (Lev 2:13)
6. Two things always excluded:
  - a. Leaven (Lev 2:11)
  - b. Honey (Lev 2:11)

\*\*\*\*\*The Cereal Sacrifice was always done in conjunction with the Blood Sacrifices and most of the time with the Burnt Sacrifice\*\*\*\*\*

### D. 1 Corinthians 11:17-29

1. Two key phrases:
  - a. “unworthy manner” = to disqualify (vs. 27)
  - b. “examine yourself” = to qualify (vs. 28)
2. How to be worthy of taking communion:
  - a. Remind yourself your NOT!!!!
  - b. Reminder to die to self.
  - c. Reminder of God’s great love for you.
  - d. Reminder to confess.
  - e. Reminder of a time to be thankful for what He has done.
