Two metaphors to offer Israel an accurate picture of themselves.

Ezekiel 15

Jerusalem compared to a useless vine.

Home enjoyment: Compare Ezekiel 15 and John 15:1-11.

Ezekiel 16

VS 1-14 - The Lord describes Jerusalem's choosing.

VS 15-22 - Jerusalem takes the glory God gave her and misuses it to bring herself glory.

VS 23-29 - Jerusalem showed no discretion, but freely allowed every worldly influence to enter into her.

VS 30-34 - Jerusalem freely gives herself away because of a brazen heart.

VS 35-43 - Jerusalem will be left desolate by the ones she let into her life.

VS 44-52 - God compares Jerusalem to it's 'sister's' Samaria and Sodom.

VS 53-58 God promises to restore Sodom, Samaria, and Jerusalem.

VS 59-63 - The Lord makes an Everlasting Covenant.
